- Join a club (comic book club, robotics and more)

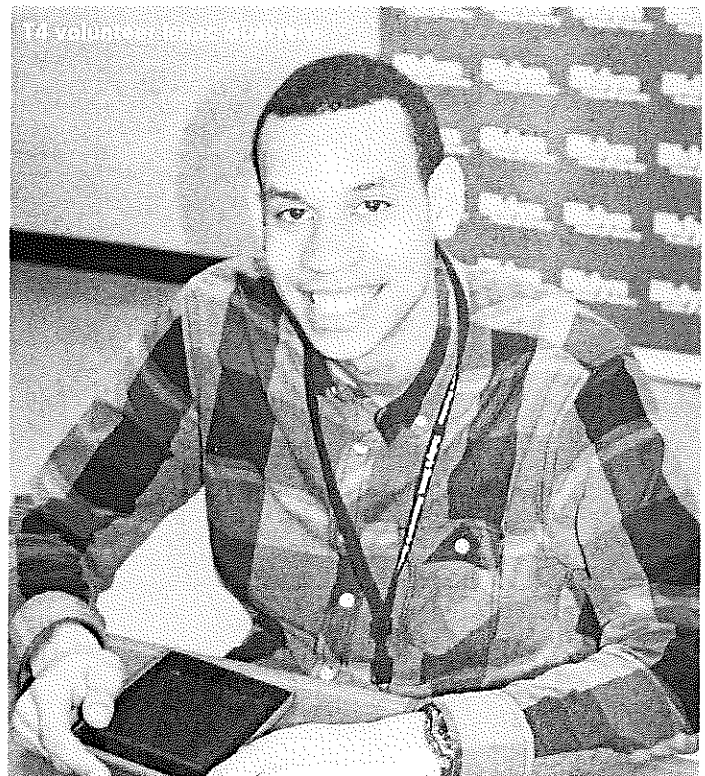
Sign Up!
